The GUNPLA BUILDERS WORLD CUP 2011 begins this July!

With regional meets in 13 locations worldwide leading up to a world championship meet in December

Beginning this July, Bandai Co., Ltd. (President & CEO: Kazunori Ueno, Headquarters: Taito-ku, Tokyo) will launch the "GUNPLA BUILDERS WORLD CUP 2011" in 13 locations worldwide including Japan, to determine the greatest Gunpla builder in the world. This is the first ever global Gunpla tournament hosted by Bandai Co., Ltd. ("Bandai").

Builders will pit their building skills, painting techniques, and ideas against one another in two age brackets, the Open Course for contestants aged 15 and over and the Junior Course for contestants aged 14 and under. Regional meets begin in July in locations worldwide, and the champions from each location will compete in the "GUNPLA EXPO WORLD TOUR HONG KONG 2011" world championship in December.
